I first heard about the work that you are doing as a medical doctor in some of our needy communities in Zambia from Mr Zou Ling who is the Chairman of Zhongrun Group of Companies and is himself a sponsor and benefactor of orphanages and communities in rural areas.

I was therefore gratified that you found time during your stay in Zambia to pay a courtesy call on me which allowed us to share experiences and ideas concerning the lot of our fellow human beings and how that might be improved. Like you, I am particularly concerned about the needs of the children in the orphanages and in the rural areas that find it difficult to access quality healthcare and education. Your thoughts on how to organize free medical services for delivery to these vulnerable groups are worth trying. I took note that trial runs were done at two communities.
